

Textkraft storage options

Valid for all iPad versions 3.x and iPhone versions 1.x. Not any Textkraft version has all the features described!

- 1**: Tap this button to see the "Open file" dialog. Here you load files into Textkraft.
- 2**: When you choose **Favourites** you see the list of files you have marked with a blue star. Tap the **Edit** button in any file listing to select or deselect a star. (Callout points to the star icon in a file listing).
- 3**: The **Recent** file listing is a quick way to reopen files you have recently closed. The **Clear** button in the top right of this view allows you to wipe the list.
- 4**: **iTunes File Sharing** is the local storage on your device. These files and folders remain on your iPad/iPhone and are not sent to any online service. But take care: When you delete Textkraft, this storage will also be deleted. When you connect your device to a Mac or PC, you can access the local storage with iTunes. Tap on the info button for more details.
- 5**: This is the list of **Cloud Services** Textkraft supports. Tap on an entry to access the files which are stored in the corresponding cloud. You must provide your username and password for the selected service or do a registration, when you access a cloud with Textkraft for the first time. After that Textkraft can access the cloud without prompting for the password each time.
- 6**: The **info buttons** are providing detail information about the different services.
- 7**: When you tap the **Edit button**, you can disconnect from any cloud service you have connected to Textkraft. (Callout points to the Edit button in the Open dialog).
- 8**: **iCloud Drive** is available with iOS 8 or newer. This option can also provide access to other apps and services who have an iOS 8 extension installed on your device.
