

Creating text selections with Textkraft

Valid for all iPad versions 3.x and iPhone versions 1.x. Not any Textkraft version has all the features described!

- Fast navigation in large documents, with jump back to the cursor
- Select word, sentence or paragraph with just a tap
- Extend text selections to the left and right without finger fractures
- Change capitalization with one tap – no navigation required

1 This button opens the **selection guide**. Close it by either hitting the button again or by tapping anywhere on the keyboard area. On iPhones you can also tap the text area to hide it.

2 The buttons on the first line select the **word, sentence or paragraph** which is closest to your current cursor position with just one tap.

3 In the second line you find functions to easily extend your current selection without the need of grabbing the little selection handles.

- The "<" and ">" buttons expand your selection by one character to the left, or to the right.
- When your selection was created by the word, sentence or paragraph buttons, the "<<" and ">>" functions extend your selection either by a word, sentence or paragraph. When the selection was not created by one of these buttons or when you inflate the cursor position to a selection, they always work word-wise.

4 The "X" button cycles through three different states:

- The first tap places the cursor to the **end of the current selection**.
- Tap it again to return to the **initial cursor position** which was active before you created the selection.
- A third tap **recreates the selection** which was visible before you used the "X" button the first time.

Create any selection and tap the "X" multiple times to get a better idea of how this works.

5 The buttons on the bottom line **copy or cut** the current selection to the clipboard or **pastes** the text from the clipboard to the current cursor position, replacing a selection, if present.
